### Reading and reading fluency:

The Final Year by Matt Goodfellow, an author who has previously visited our school, is a verse novel following 10-year-old Nate through his challenging Year 6 in primary school. Amidst SATs pressure, changing friendships, and bullying, Nate navigates his anger and family struggles, finding a voice through writing encouraged by a new teacher, Mr. Joshua.



### Literacy Skills

This term we will look at narratives, using 'The Hunger Games' as a writing stimulus. Class 4 will continue to include all the year 5/6 grammar taught so far, while focusing on precisising dialogue to advance the action and adapt the formality of their writing and choosing vocabulary carefully to convey complicated information concisely.

We will then move on to a fantasy story based on our next book 'the sky song' where children will be writing a narrative piece, building on their previous work, incorporating figurative language and a flashback.

### Science

This term in science, we will learn about light using our new Ogden resources. We will learn that Light appears to travel in straight lines, and we see objects when light from them goes into our eyes. The light may come directly from light sources, but for other objects some light must be reflected from the object into our eyes for the object to be seen.

Objects that block light (are not fully transparent) will cause shadows. Because light travels in straight lines the shape of the shadow will be the same as the outline shape of the object

### RE

This term we will be exploring the question 'are all people equal?' exploring a Sikh worldview. We will explore the Sikh worldview, equality and Gurmukh. We will learn that we can better understand people's worldviews when we find out more about context, Waheguru is the Eternal Guru- Satguru (the 'true guru') is another name for Waheguru, Sikhi is the path of active learning from the Guru, Gurmukh is achieving union with Satguru, Sikh people believe that all people can achieve Gurmukh because all people are equal, some of the Sikh gurus strongly promoted equality and some Sikh women experience sexism

### ART



This term class 4 will be looking at digital art and collages through studying the work of Liu Bolin and Thandiwe Mariu. They will then be creating a self-portrait in the style of their work.

### ICT

In this unit, children will use the micro bits to create a code in order to sense movement. They will modify codes, identify inputs and outputs before creating their own step counter.

This term PE will be on a Tuesday exploring Athletics looking at sprinting, relays, long jump and triple jump. On Wednesday, we will be looking at rounders where we will be developing throwing, catching striking and fielding skills.
