In reading we will....

Our daily story time book will be a selection of books including The Can Caravan by Richard O'Neill.



Phonics/Read Write Inc

The children will continue their Read Write Inc journey learning and progressing at their own level. They will bring home reading books and a reading for pleasure book. On the sticker in their reading diary, there will be a QR code which you can scan for further reading practise. Please practise reading as much as possible, building up the children's fluency until they can read each word on sight without Fred Talking. The reading for pleasure book may be read by yourselves with your child.

Writing

The children have now secured writing CVC words. Their next step is to segment to spell words using the growing number of special friends that they are learning in their phonics sessions. A copy of these can be found on the website class page. Most children are using finger spaces in their writing and this term they will be introduced to full stops and capital letters as they prepare for transition into Year 1. The aim for the end of this year is that all children can write simple sentences that can be read by themselves and others.

Personal, Social and Emotional

This term, the children will grow in independence and develop their resilience and a positive mindset as they prepare for their transition into Year 1. They will be given lots of opportunities to work collaboratively as a group, encouraging all children to voice their ideas as well as listen to others. They will be encouraged to go back to a piece of learning to add more to it or edit it if necessary.

DT - textiles

This term the children will be exploring free standing structures. They will use a range of construction kits to explore building, connecting and testing the strength of their creations. Pupils will also explore junk modelling.

PE

This half term the children will be having their PE lessons outside. They will learn to throw and catch a range of different objects including balls, quoits and bean bags. They will also learn the skills needed for Sports Day, including how to encourage others, try their best and enjoy themselves! The children will need shorts, t-shirt and trainers. PE is on a Monday. In our outdoor area children will practise the throwing catching skills taught in the PE lessons.



Maths

Throughout this term, Reception children will:

- Confidently subitise numbers to 5, developing confidence when subitising to 10.
- Composition of numbers to 10
- Comparing numbers using the vocabulary of more, than, less than and equal to
- Sharing equally
- Odd and even numbers
- Measures – days of the week, ordering events that happen in the day, describing and sorting 3D shapes and repeating patterns beyond the simple ABAB pattern.

All of the above will be taught, learned and applied through an engaging combination of games, challenges and investigations, both during a whole class input and in their continuous provision.

Understanding the world

This term, the children will be focusing on a topic of 'Around the world'. As school re-starts, we are hoping that some of our caterpillars will be ready to transform into butterflies. The children will consider the different clothing needed to visit hot and cold places and the different animals that live in these environments. They will explore the signs of summer and compare these to the other seasonal changes they have witnessed through the year. The children will learn about the monarchy in England, including King Charles III and our previous monarch Queen Elizabeth II. Finally, they will reflect on their time during their first year at school.

Music

The term our music units are Slap, clap, clap and Bow, bow bow Belinda. They will also further develop understanding of the meaning of genre, pulse, beat and rhythm.
