In reading we will....

Our daily story time book will be a selection of stories, including The Little Red Hen.



Phonics/Read Write Inc

The children will begin their Read Write Inc journey learning and progressing at their own level. They will bring home a reading book and a reading for pleasure book each week. Whilst they are learning the fundamentals to reading, the children in Reception will bring home a wordless book for them to practise story-telling. The reading for pleasure book may be read by yourselves with your child. Once they can blend words, they will begin bringing home a worded reading book.

Writing

In Reception, the children will be working on their letter formation. They will be learning to write their name and labels. They will develop holding the pencil correctly in the tripod grip.

Personal, Social and Emotional

This term, the children will be getting settled into their new learning environment, exploring the different opportunities on offer. They will be building relationships with their peers and adults, both in the classroom and the wider school environment. They will be establishing routines, learning to share, take turns and learning to tidy up themselves.

Maths

Throughout this term, Reception children will:

- Count to 10 orally
- Understand how to represent, compose and compare numbers to 3
- Understanding counting as pointing to each object and the number we stop counting out is how many there are
- Match and sort objects
- Compare size, mass and capacity – it is bigger/smaller/heavier/lighter/holds more/holds less
- Copy and continue simple ABABAB patterns

All of the above will be taught, learnt and applied through an engaging combination of games, challenges and

Understanding the world

This term, the children will be learning about who they are and who is in their family. They will learn about how they have changed since being a baby. They will explore the classroom, both inside and outside, and learn the basic skills of mapping. They will also learn what harvest is and why it is so important.

Computing

The children will be shown how to use ipads to take photos and also to scan QR codes with links to phonics learning and stories. They will use Paint Sparkle to practise their letter formation.

PE

The children will need to bring their PE kit into school in a named bag every Monday. They will bring this home every Friday. In PE the children will be learning about balancing on large and small body parts, how to do a pencil roll as well as how to mount and dismount apparatus safely.



Art

The children will explore and create through a variety of mediums including paint, pencil, oil and chalk pastels and collage. We will specifically work on our sketching skills.



RE

This term, the children will learn about themselves and how they belong. They will learn about how they are all special and that they can celebrate their differences. The vocabulary God, Christian, Muslim, Hindu and Jew will be introduced.

Music

The children will sing a variety of literacy, numeracy and topic-related songs. They will also develop understanding of the meaning of genre, pulse, beat and rhythm.
