### In reading we will...

### Phonics/Read Write Inc

The children will continue their Read Write Inc. journey, learning and progressing at their own level. Your child will bring home a RWInc reading book and a reading for pleasure book each week.

To help your child, please encourage your child to read their reading book to you daily, where possible. This will help build up their phonic knowledge and fluency. Also discuss with your child what they have read ensuring they have a secure understanding of the text. The reading for pleasure book may be read by yourselves with your child.

### Spellings

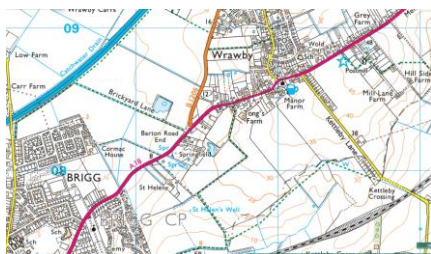
Children will learn a new spelling pattern each week. Children will learn ten spellings a week. These will be taught in school. A copy of spellings can be found on the school website under Class 1.

### Geography

The learning question for this half term is 'What is special about 'our place''.

We will be look at directional language, such as North, East, South and West. Using maps of our school and local area, we will locate physical features and human features. Then

we will create our own map of the school grounds with a key.



### Maths Skills

Year 1 will learn:

- **Time** – Days of the week, months of the year, time to o'clock
- **Place value** - Counting on and back from 20, understanding the value of, being able to write these numbers.
- **Calculation** – One more and one less, add two numbers with totals within 20
- Practice the formation of the digits 0 – 9

All of the above will be taught and learned through an engaging combination of games, challenges and investigations, both independently and with their peers.

*To help your child, you may wish to practice counting to and from 20, encourage talking about the time in everyday*

### Literacy Skills

Our driving text will be, 'The Gingerbread Man'. We will be asking questions about the text, sequencing events; recognising and joining in with predictable phrases; creating story maps; and retelling the story.

The children will be concentrating on building a great sentence, which will include: finger spaces, capital letters to demarcate sentences, full stops and adding the prefix –ed to root words.

### Computing

The children will develop their understanding of how technology can help them in their everyday lives. They will become familiar with different components of a computer, including the keyboard and the mouse. They will consider how to use technology safely.

### Science

The children will learn about animals including humans. We will find out what living things are and what they need. We will be finding about animal groups and their characteristics. We will spend time learning scientific language and we will observe animals around our school.

### PE

The children will have PE lessons on Mondays and Wednesdays. We will be developing our gymnastic skills through body management and locomotion.

### Art

We will be developing our painting skills this term. We will be learning to control our brushes to create different shades, lines and textures.

### RE

This term, we shall consider the question: What does the Qur'an say about how Muslims should treat others and live their lives?

### Music

This term, we will be finding the beat listening, singing, playing composing and performing.
