## Spring term 1 2024 Class 1 Reception



### In reading we will....

Our daily story time book will be a selection of books including The Three Little Wolves and the Big Bad Pig by Eugene Trivizas and Oi Frog by Kes Grey.



### Phonics/Read Write Inc

The children will continue their Read Write Inc journey learning and progressing at their own level. They will bring home a reading book and a reading for pleasure book each week. The children have now started to bring home a sound blending book each week. Some children will also bring home a reading sheet every 3 days or so. Please practise reading as much as possible, building up the children's fluency until they can read each word on sight without Fred Talking. The reading for pleasure book may be read by yourselves with your child.

### Writing

In Reception, the children will focus on using finger spaces to write captions with three words. They will consolidate letter formation and segmenting to spell words using Fred Talk. Their wider writing focus will include retelling of a story, designing a lost poster and writing instructions.

### Personal, Social and Emotional

This term, the children will be encouraged to hold back and forth conversations with their peers and adults in the room, responding appropriately to what has been discussed. They will be encouraged to show patience and self-control when waiting for a turn. They will learn to become more independent with dressing and undressing including fastening zips on coats.

### Art

The children will explore and create through a variety of mediums including paint, pencil, oil and chalk pastels and collage. Our study will be winter trees.



### PE

The children will work on controlling their movements. They will explore moving in time with the music, moving in a straight line and negotiating space in terms of moving around, over and under various obstacles. The children will need to bring their PE kit into school in a named bag every Monday. They will bring this home every Friday.



### Maths

Throughout this term, Reception children will:

- Counting and subitising numbers to 7
- 1 more and 1 less than numbers to 5
- Composition of numbers to 7
- Continue to count up to 20 and back from 10
- Recognise the numerals 0 to 10
- Sort, recognise and name the 2D shapes square, rectangle, circle and triangle
- Recognise that shapes can be turned and flipped to make other shapes
- Sort 3D shapes
- Describe, continue, create and fix repeating patterns

All of the above will be taught, learned and applied through an engaging combination of games, challenges and investigations, both during a whole class input and in their continuous provision.

### Understanding the world

This term, the children will be learning about their local area including the school grounds and the route they take to walk to church. They will be introduced to physical and human features. The children will also consider different types of transport and when we might use these. They will compare their local geography to what it is like in London. At the end of the half term, the children will learn about Chinese New Year which supports our learning about diversity in England. Throughout the school year we will be learning about seasonal changes.

### Music

This term we will learn and sing songs. Our units of study are Bird spotting and shake my silliness out. Through these units we will continue to further develop our understanding of the meaning of genre, pulse, beat and rhythm.
