In reading we will...

Our daily story time book will be a selection of books including *The Three Little Wolves and the Big Bad Pig* by Eugene Trivizas and *Oi Frog* by Kes Grey.



Phonics/Read Write Inc

The children will continue their Read Write Inc. journey, learning and progressing at their own level. Your child will bring home a RWInc reading book and a reading for pleasure book each week.

To help your child, please encourage your child to read their reading book to you daily, where possible. This will help build up their phonic knowledge and fluency. Also discuss with your child what they have read ensuring they have a secure understanding of the text. The reading for pleasure book may be read by yourselves with your child.

Spellings

Children will learn a new spelling pattern each week. Children will learn ten spellings a week. These will be taught in school. A copy of spellings can be found on the school website under Class 1.

Geography

This term in Geography, the children will be exploring the seven continents of the world and revisiting the four countries of the United Kingdom. We will then be learning about the continent of Asia, with a focus on the country of Sri Lanka. We will compare some locations in Sri Lanka to the village of Wrawby. As part of this unit of work, the children will be developing their skills by using atlases and maps to find information about the locations we are studying. As a final lesson, the children will use the information they have learned to say whether they would prefer to live in England or Sri Lanka.

PE

The children will have their PE lessons on Mondays and Wednesdays. This half-term we will be exploring different types of movement through Dance.

Art

This term we will be developing our pencil skills to create pattern and texture. Our completed piece will be an observational drawing.



Maths Skills

Throughout this term, children will learn:

- **Counting** – count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning at any number; Count in 2's and 10's to 100.
- **Time** – Tell the time to o'clock and half past; Consider times in the day and night, e.g. 8 o'clock in the morning and 8 o'clock at night
- **Calculation** – Addition and subtraction within 20, using the addition and subtraction signs and finding missing numbers.
- **Number** – Read and write number words up to 15; Read and write numbers to 50 in numerals; Count along a number line

All of the above will be taught and learned through an engaging combination of games, challenges and investigations, both independently and with their peers.

Literacy Skills

This term we will be starting by looking at instructions. Children will read and follow instructions and then write their own instructions for a game.

We will then move onto report writing. Children will collect information from different sources on predators and write a report based on their findings.

Children will use a range of GPAs skills. These will include capital letters, full stops, imperative verbs, lists and joining sentences with 'and'.

Computing

This term children will learn about data and information. They will begin by using labels to put objects into groups and labelling these groups. They will then begin to demonstrate their ability to sort objects into different groups, based on the properties they choose.

Science

In Science this term pupils will explore Materials. They will name and investigate and name the materials which make up the world around them. They will explore their properties and plan tests to challenge their scientific thinking.

RE

This term, we shall consider the question: How is Allah described in the Qur'an?

Music

This term we will learn and sing songs. Our units of study are Bird spotting and shake my silliness out. Through these units we will continue to further develop our understanding of the meaning of genre, pulse, beat and rhythm.
