Phonics/Read Write Inc

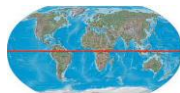
The children will continue their Read Write Inc. journey, learning and progressing at their own level. Your child will bring home a RWInc reading book and a reading for pleasure book each week. To help your child, please encourage your child to read their reading book to you daily, where possible. This will help build up their phonic knowledge and fluency. Also discuss with your child what they have read ensuring they have a secure understanding of the text. The reading for pleasure book may be read by yourselves with your child.

Spellings

Children will learn a new spelling pattern each week. Children will learn ten spellings a week. These will be taught in school. A copy of spellings can be found on the school website under Class 1.

Geography

This half term we are looking at Sri Lanka and India a little more. We will find the equator and discuss what effect it has on the temperature of different countries, including looking at countries where they have snow and countries where they don't. Further to this, we will consider whether it would ever snow in Sri Lanka and use our reasoning skills to explain our answers.



PE

The children will have PE lessons on Mondays and Wednesdays. The children will be learning skills in athletics and developing net and wall techniques.

Art

Our work this term is on ceramics. We will be exploring the medium of clay and using clay to create sculpture linked to our history work on London.



Maths Skills

Throughout this term, children will learn:

- **Counting** – count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning at any number; Count in 2's, 5's and 10's to 100; Read and write numbers to 100.
- **Calculation – Addition and Subtraction** add and subtract numbers within 20; number bonds to 20 **Multiplication** - building, drawing and describing arrays using repeated addition **Division** - understanding and using equal grouping and sharing
- **Money** – know the value of coins and notes

All of the above will be taught and learned through an engaging combination of games, challenges and investigations, both independently and with their peers.

To help your child, you may wish to use coins at home and when shopping, discussing the value of each coin. Also lots of counting, particularly in 2's and 5's which can be done in fun ways whilst being active.

Literacy Skills

This half-term we will be building on the children's knowledge acquired in history last half-term. We will start by reading Vlad and the Great Fire of London. The children will plan and re-tell the story from Vlad's perspective.

GPaS

Yr 1 – Will focus on writing a range of sentences and punctuating them using capital letters, full stop, exclamation marks and question marks.

Computing

This term children will learn using the laptops to create digital writing. They will login to their own accounts then practice skills becoming familiar with the keyboard including using the space bar, back space and shift keys. They will experiment with changing the font style, size and colour ensuring that its use matches its purpose.

Science

Our Science work this term will be all about plants. We will identify and name a variety of wild and common garden plants including deciduous and evergreen trees. We will think about how plants grow and will plant bean seeds and observe what happens as they germinate, grow and develop.

RE

This term, we shall consider the question: Why does Easter matter to Christians?

Music

Our units this term are Down There Under the Sea and It's oh so Quiet. We will be exploring song, rhythm, rhyme and using percussion instruments.
