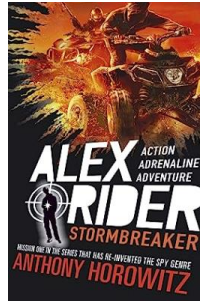


Wrawby St Mary's C of E Primary School

Year 6 Autumn Term 2 2023



This term we will continue reading Stormbreaker, by Anthony Horowitz. In the first book in the number one bestselling Alex Rider series by Anthony Horowitz, fourteen-year-old Alex is forcibly recruited into MI6. Armed with secret gadgets, he is sent to investigate Herod Sayle, a man who is offering state-of-the-art Stormbreaker computers to every school in the Country.



Maths Skills

This half term will be focusing on:

Number: Place value – using negative numbers in context and calculating intervals across zero and rounding any whole number

Ratio and Proportion – solving problems involving the relative sizes of two quantities, finding missing values and solving problems involving similar shapes using scale factor

Algebra – using simple formulae and describing linear number sequences

Measurement – converting between standard units of measure, calculating area and perimeter using formulae

Geometry – compare shapes based on properties and sizes, draw 2D shapes and learn about parts of a circle, recognise and calculate missing angles, describe positions on the full coordinate grid, draw and translate shapes

History

In history we will be looking at 'how does the impacts of WW2 justify the sacrifice?' Learning about when did WW2 take place, why did Britain join the war, why the battle of Britain took place and how the Blitz affected Britain.

RE

We will be exploring the question 'Do you have to believe in God to be good?' This unit will give us an opportunity to study religions and worldviews that do not have a concept of God, such as Buddhism and Humanism.

Science

This half term we will be learning about Living Things and their Habitats in Science, with a focus on

- Describing how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including micro-organisms, plants and animals.
- Giving reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics.

Computing

The children will be introduced to creating websites for a chosen purpose, learning what makes a good web page and using this to design and evaluate their own website using Google Sites.

English

This term in English we will be writing a Narrative piece based on 'Harry Potter under the stairs' this will also link to anti-bullying week. In this piece we will look at using dialogue to enhance the action and precisising. We are then going to move onto a newspaper report linking to Harry Potter where we will begin to look at passive voice and to aim to include a shift in formality within our writing. Our independent piece will be a newspaper report on 'The Christmas Truce' linking to our current history unit. In the final week of term, we will look at cinquain poetry, which is a poem that consist of 5 lines.

Art/DT

This half term, our DT focus is on balanced diets and nutrition and will link to our History, learning about the Second World War. We will discover and be able to explain where and how a variety of ingredients are grown, reared, caught and processed. We will then use this knowledge to create our own recipe for a seasonal stew which could have been cooked during WWII.

PE

In PE this term we will be looking at gymnastics on Tuesdays with Miss Balderson and on Thursdays, we will be looking at inclusive games with Miss Saxby and Miss Pearson.
