Reading

Our class read this term will be a non-fiction book, 'We are the Romans' by David Long & Allen Fatimaharan, where we will travel back in time to meet members from Ancient Roman Society from slave to Emperor.

History

This term, we consider the question:

'What have archaeologists learnt from Early Britons?'

Children will become historians by discovering how early Brits were different to us. We will learn about what they ate and how they communicated. We will explore what life would have been like for early settlers by analysing various secondary sources of evidence. Children will also put historical events into order, thinking about the different eras in the Stone Age.



RE

Islamic worldview

This half term we will be exploring the Islamic Worldview by learning 'What the main concepts in Islam reveal about the nature of Allah? What are the purposes of the visual symbols in a mosque?'

Design and Technology

This half term, we will be tasting and testing different biscuits, exploring ingredients and packaging, before creating an alternative recipe and designing our own.



Science This term, we will begin by learning about the leader and pioneer Lord William Armstrong.

Our main Science focus will be **'Health and Movement.'**

We will be learning about the right types of nutrition animals and humans need. We will explore how we get nourishment from what we eat. We will also be exploring and identifying that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement. When answering these questions, we will be working scientifically by grouping and classifying things, recording findings and noticing patterns.

Maths Skills

Throughout this term, children will explore and apply their understanding of:

Subtraction - subtract numbers with up to three digits, using formal written methods of column subtraction

Length - measure and compare lengths in m, cm and mm. Also learning how to measure the perimeter of simple 2-D shapes.

Multiplication - recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 4 and 8 multiplication tables.

Division - learning how to write and calculate when a two digit number is divided by a one digit number.

To help your child: spend 5 mins a day chanting the 3, 4, and 8 times tables. Also, use the TTRockstars login and move through the levels.

Literacy Skills

Our first piece of writing, this half term, will be a playscript based on the traditional tale 'Hansel and Gretel' followed by comparing poems by contemporary poet Matt Goodfellow. Our final piece will be a discussion - 'Does Cleethorpes make a good holiday destination?' We will then produce a piece of writing discussing the pros and cons of Cleethorpes as a holiday destination.

Computing

This half term, the children will be introduced to a selection of motion, sound and event blocks in the program Scratch. We will use this knowledge to create a representation of a piano.

PE

Children's designated PE days will be a Tuesday and a Friday. Children need to bring their PE kit into school on a Monday and take it home on a Friday. Please ensure all kit is clearly named.
