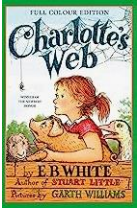


# Wrawby St Mary's C of E Primary School

## Summer Term 2 2024



### Reading



This half term we will be reading the children's classic Charlotte's Web. 'Some Pig'. 'Humble'. 'Radiant'. These are the words in Charlotte's Web, high up in Zuckerman's barn. Charlotte's spiderweb tells of her feelings for a little pig named Wilbur, who simply wants a friend.

### History

This term, we consider the question:

#### **'Why did the Vikings come to Britain?'**

We are super excited to delve into this topic after our recent trip to Murton Park. Children will become historians by learning who the Vikings were and how they affected the local area. We will find out how the Vikings lived and how they travelled. Then thinking about the Viking reputation and analysing if they were vicious raiders. We will then evaluate our knowledge on the Vikings to be able to answer our question 'Why did the Vikings come to Britain?'



### RE

This half term we will be thinking about the question 'What does it mean to live a good life?' To answer this question, we will look at the beliefs of different religions and how it helps them live a good life.



### Computing

During this half term, the children will be using desktop publishing software. They will consider careful choices of font size, colour and type to edit and improve premade documents.

### Science

This term, our science focus will be 'light'. We will discover and explain what a light source is and know that darkness is the absence of light. We will explore which objects light can travel through and which don't allow light to travel through them. Children will investigate how to make shadows of different sizes and shapes. We will then investigate if light can be reflected from surfaces.

When answering these questions, we will be working scientifically by setting up simple practical enquiries, making careful observations and recording findings.

### Maths Skills

Throughout this term, children will explore and apply their understanding of:

**multiplication**– to multiply two-digit numbers times a one digit number using the formal written method.

**Division** –to divide two-digit number by a one digit number using the formal written method.

**time**– read roman numerals to 12, estimate and read time with increasing accuracy.

**geometry** – recognise and make 3-D shapes using modelling materials  
**number, addition and subtraction**– estimate answers and use inverse operations.

**To help your child:** spend 5 mins a day chanting the 2, 3,4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables. Also, use the TTRockstars login

### Literacy Skills

Our first piece of writing, this half term, will be a recount of our forthcoming trip to Gainsborough Old Hall in the form of a letter to entertain their audience.

After this, we will be writing a narrative using the book 'Escape from Pompeii' by Christina Ballit as inspiration. The children will then innovate this story to create their own.

### Design and technology

This half term, the children will be incorporating switches, bulbs and buzzers into a created product; gathering design ideas, ordering the main stages of making and evaluating.

### PE

Children's designated PE days will be a Tuesday and a Friday.

The children will be taught athletics and stiking and fielding.

Children need to bring their PE kit into school on a Monday and take it home on a Friday. Please ensure all kit is clearly named.
