## In reading we will...

Our daily story time book will be a selection of books including The Can Caravan by Richard O'Neill.



## Phonics/Read Write Inc

The children will continue their Read Write Inc. journey, learning and progressing at their own level. Your child will bring home a RWInc reading book and a reading for pleasure book each week.

To help your child, please encourage your child to read their reading book to you daily, where possible. This will help build up their phonic knowledge and fluency. Also discuss with your child what they have read ensuring they have a secure understanding of the text. Please log children's reading on the Learning with parents app. The reading for pleasure book may be read by yourselves with your child.

## Spellings

Children will learn a new spelling pattern each week. Children will learn ten spellings a week. These will be taught in school. A copy of spellings can be found on the school website under Class 1.

## History

This half term we will be investigating the question – Do all heroes wear capes?

We shall look at the lives of significant individuals from the past who have contributed to national and international achievements.

During our investigations we shall identify some famous people that have helped to make our lives better today. These people may be doctors, nurses, dentists, scientists inventors or explorers.

## PE

The children will have PE lessons on Mondays and Thursdays. The children will be learning skills in athletics and sending and receiving.

## DT

This half term the children exploring strong structures for a purpose. They will be designing and making a boat from junk materials.



## Maths Skills

### Reception

- **Composition** – what makes the numbers 6 – 10
- **Shape** – circles, triangles, squares and rectangles
- **Pattern** – patterns in the environment, circular patterns
- **Measures** – comparing mass/weight and capacity
- **Time** – sequencing events, days of the week

### Year 1

- **Counting** – count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning at any number; Count in 2's, 5's and 10's to 100; Read and write number words one to twenty
- **Number** – halves and quarters of quantities
- **Calculation** – doubles to double 10, sharing equally and grouping for division
- **Geometry** – position and direction, left and right, whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns
- **Measures** – compare, describe and measure mass and capacity; comparing time

## Literacy Skills

This half term we will start by writing a recount of our visit to Normanby Hall. They will then read The Lion Inside by Rachel Bright and Jim Field and write their own version of the story. The Reception children will be consolidating their ability to write a simple sentence that can be read by others.

The Year 1 children will be consolidating their ability to demarcate sentences correctly and extend sentences using 'and'.

## Computing

This term children will be introduced to on-screen programming through ScratchJr. The children will use a variety of sprites and backgrounds. They will explore the blocks and learn to join them as an introduction to algorithms. By the end of the unit they will have designed their own animation project.

## Science

This term the children will be consolidating and developing their knowledge of the seasons. They will learn about the changes that take place, the weather and how this affects the clothes which we wear.

## RE

This term we will consider the question: What is the good news Jesus brings?

## Music

We will be further developing rhythm, pulse and dynamic skills this term, exploring through seasonal songs and the use of percussion instruments.
