In reading we will....

Phonics/Read Write Inc

We follow the Read Write Inc phonic programme. In Reception, the children will learn a new sound each day and then use these sounds to blend words to read them. Whilst they are learning the fundamentals to reading, they will bring home a wordless book for them to practise story-telling. In Year 1, the children will bring home a book matched to their reading ability. Please practise reading these books daily, where possible. All children will bring home a reading for pleasure book, which may be read by yourselves with your child. The children will bring these books home in a zip wallet. Please have these in your child's bag daily.

Spellings

In Year 1, children will learn a new spelling pattern each week. Children will learn ten spellings a week. These will be taught in school. A copy of spellings can be found on the school website under Class 1.

Geography

The learning question for this half term is 'Where do I live?'

We will be look at directional language, such as North, East, South and West.



Using maps of our school and local area, we will locate physical features and human features.

Then we will create our own map of the school grounds with a key.

PE

The children will have PE lessons on Mondays and Thursdays. We will be developing our gymnastic skills through body management and investigating different ways of moving.

Art

This term we will be developing our pencil skills. Our completed piece will be an observational drawing.



RE

This term, we will learn about special places. We will learn about our special places, the church and other religious buildings.

Music

The children will sing a variety of literacy, numeracy and topic related songs. They will develop understanding of pulse, beat and rhythm.

Maths Skills

Reception will learn:

- **Counting** – Subitising to 3, counting objects using 1:1 correspondence, comparing numbers (more, less and equal)
- **Time** – days of the week

Year 1 will learn:

- **Place value** - Count to and back from 20, understanding the value of, being able to write these numbers. Ordering numbers and finding missing numbers.
- **Calculation** – One more and one less, finding the total of two single digit numbers, introduction of the equals sign in a number sentence
- Practice the formation of the digits 0 – 9
- **Time** – Days of the week, months of the year, time to o'clock

All of the above will be taught and learned through an engaging combination of games, challenges and investigations, both independently and with their peers.

Literacy Skills

Our driving text will be, 'Goldilocks and the three bears'. We will be asking questions about the text, sequencing events; recognising and joining in with predictable phrases; creating story maps; and retelling the story. After this, we will be changing the porridge that Goldilocks eats to a sandwich! We will then be making our own sandwiches and writing instructions to show others how to make one.

In Reception, children will be learning the formation of letters and recording initial sounds. In Year 1, children will be demarcating sentences with capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Computing

The children will develop their understanding of how technology can help them in their everyday lives. They will become familiar with different components of a computer, including the keyboard and the mouse. They will consider how to use technology safely.

Science

The children will learn about animals including humans. They will name their body parts and their five senses. They will learn about their teeth, how to look after them and which foods to eat to keep their teeth healthy. Throughout the year the children will look for signs of the changing seasons.
