### In reading we will...

Our daily story time book will be a selection of books including Little people, Big Dreams David Attenborough and Oi Frog by Kes Grey.



### Phonics/Read Write Inc

The children will continue their Read Write Inc. journey, learning and progressing at their own level. Your child will bring home a RWInc reading book and a reading for pleasure book each week.

To help your child, please encourage your child to read their reading book to you daily, where possible. This will help build up their phonic knowledge and fluency. Also discuss with your child what they have read ensuring they have a secure understanding of the text. Please log children's reading on the Learning with parents app. The reading for pleasure book may be read by yourselves with your child.

### Spellings

Children will learn a new spelling pattern each week. Children will learn ten spellings a week. These will be taught in school. A copy of spellings can be found on the school website under Class Pages, Class 1.

### History

Our big question for this half term in History is:

Who am I?  
My family  
and celebrations

Enquiry questions:

1. Can you remember your last birthday?
2. What did you celebrate in Autumn?
3. Why do we celebrate Christmas?
4. Why do we celebrate a New Year?
5. Why is Easter in Spring?

### Maths Skills

Throughout this term, children will learn:

- **counting** – count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning at any number; Count in 2's, 5's and 10's to 100.
- **shape** –name common 3D shapes including cones, cylinders, spheres, pyramids, cubes and cuboids.
- **measurement** – time – half past, weight and capacity – comparing
- **pattern**
- **number** – division – sharing by grouping, fractions - halves and quarters.

All of the above will be taught and learned through an engaging combination of games, challenges and investigations, both independently and with their peers.

**To help your child, you may wish to find examples of 3D shapes around your house or when you are outside; talk about halves and quarters when you are eating foods such as cakes, pizzas, apples, etc.**

### Literacy Skills

This half term we will be reading

Our GPaS skills in Year 1 will include composing sentences using the conjunction 'so' and writing the singular/plural of words.

### Computing

This term, children will learn how to move a robot. They will explore using individual commands, both with other learners and as part of a computer program. They will identify what each floor robot command does and use that knowledge to start predicting the outcome of programs.

### Science

The children will learn about pioneers and leaders, focusing on David Attenborough. They will learn about the documentaries he has made about animals and nature and the leading work he has done to make people aware of climate change. The children will consider how they can help care for our planet.

### PE

The children will have PE lessons on Mondays (outdoor kit and trainers needed) and Thursdays. The children will be learning skills needed for dance and sending and receiving objects.

### DT

This term, Class 1 will be exploring "Healthy Eating – Food – A Fact of Life". The children will learn how to prepare a variety of different fruits and vegetables for eating.

### RE

This term, we shall consider the question: What do Christians believe God is like?

### Music

The children will develop their rhythm and pulse knowledge using their voices and percussion instruments.
