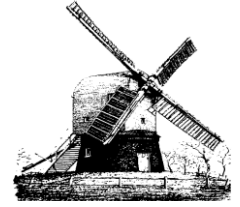


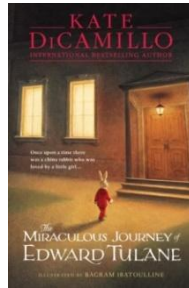

Reading

Maths Skills

Throughout this term, children will explore and apply their understanding of: **Statistics** – creating bar charts and line graphs (Y4) from a set of data about our class.

Multiplication – we will recap build it and draw it methods of multiplication before working on formal written methods.

Division – we will recap build it and draw it methods of division before working on formal written methods.

Geometry – looking at properties of shapes and understanding the relationship between angles and turning of shapes. Year 4 will also look at angles of triangles and moving shapes on a grid.

History

This term, we are going to explore the Victorian era. We shall look at the Georgians, who came before, and then the reign of Queen Victoria and what her life was like. We will investigate key events of the Victorian era, such as the industrial revolution. This will team up nicely with our Victorian experience day at Wilderspin on 30th June, where we will experience a school day as the children in Victorian times did. Then we will look at the transition into the Edwardian era.

RE

This term, we will continue to investigate 'What kind of world did Jesus want'. We will explore how Jesus and His disciples lived and consider how this relates to how we live.

Art

DT this half term focuses on packaging. We will investigate different packaging to find out what should be included on it. We shall deconstruct some packaging to help understand how it is constructed. We will then create a net for our packaging for a product of our choice.

Literacy Skills

Our first English focus is information leaflets. We will learn how to write persuasively to advertise Wrawby St Mary's school for future children. The second focus will be a recount, in the form of a diary entry. This will tie in with our trip to Wilderspin, and we will write a diary entry from the perspective of a Victorian child after a day at school.

Spanish

This half term in Spanish, we will learn some vocabulary for the seasons of the year. We will then team this up with learning the months of the year too.

Science

In science, our topic for this half term is sound. We will learn how sounds are created, how they travel and how we are able to hear them. We will do some investigations to understand how we can change the way sound travels by changing different variables. Pitch and volume will also be investigated to find the similarities and differences between the two. We will think about how distance can affect how long sound takes to reach us, but also how distance can affect the volume of the sound too.

Computing

This half term the children will be using a range of techniques to edit photographs. We will discuss the positives and negatives around editing and changing photos, as well as learning simple fixes that can improve minor errors.

PE

Children's designated PE days will be a Monday and a Tuesday. Children need to bring their PE kit into school on a Monday and take it home on a Friday. Please ensure all kit is clearly named. This half term in Athletics and Striking and Fielding.
