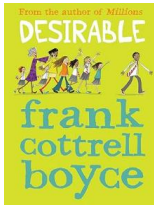

### Reading



When George gets an out-of-date aftershave for his birthday, he isn't particularly impressed. But the aftershave seems to have developed some extra properties...and George is now irresistible to every girl around!

### History

This term, we consider the question: How do the achievements of the Ancient Egyptians compare to those of the Early Britons?

We will look at the early settlers and decide why the River Nile was so important in this area of Africa. We will move on to study the Ancient Pyramids and the traditions following the death of the pharaoh, including mummification and the weighing of the heart ceremony. We will discover why Tutankhamun is more famous now than he was as a young pharaoh and how the Romans brought an end to this fascinating, pioneering civilization.

### RE

This term, we will continue to explore faith through a Muslim worldview. We will look at how Muslims live out their faith and focus in on one British pioneer such as Zane Malik or Mo Farah.

### Design and Technology

This half term in DT, we are going to look at a food pioneer – celebrity chef and author - Nadiya Hussain. We will look at seasonal fruits and vegetables and create our own recipes in order to prepare and cook a fruit crumble.

### Maths Skills

Throughout this term, children will explore and apply their understanding of:

**Number** – multiply and divide 2-digit or 3-digit numbers by a 1-digit number using a formal method.

**Fractions** – recognising fractions of a discrete set of objects.

solve problems involving increasingly harder fractions to calculate quantities, and fractions to divide quantities.

**Geometry** – identify right angles, recognise that two right angles make a half-turn, three make three quarters of a turn and four a complete turn; identify whether angles are greater than or less than a right angle.

### Literacy Skills

This half-term we will be using *Escape From Pompeii* by Christina Balit to inspire our narrative piece of writing.

This will focus on retelling the eruption of Mount Vesuvius as told through the eyes of a Roman child.

After that, we will be exploring poetry created by Alex Wharton in order to create short poems and limericks of our own.

### Science

In science, we will be learning about living things and their habitats.

We will consider this in terms of classification and sets of questions we could pose in order to categorise living animals or to identify specific creatures within a subset. Branching databases will be used to identify and label animals on a food chain, including producers, predators and prey.

Finally, we will look at our local habitats and discuss whether we have any threats to the local environment and whether any areas of wildlife have been encouraged.

### Computing

This half term, the children will be looking at the internet and will be given opportunities to explore the World Wide Web for themselves and decide how honest, accurate or reliable websites can be and understand the concept of fake news.

### PE
