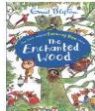

In reading we will.... Our daily story time book will include the classic story 'The Enchanted Wood' by Enid Blyton and 100 best poems for children.



Reading

Our reading lessons will focus on developing fluency and the pace of our reading, we will use our phonics skills to help us to decode and blend unknown words. In addition, we will be working on our understanding of what we have read through developing comprehension skills. We will be learning new vocabulary that links to our weekly texts. We will be introduced to questioning skills this year and this term our focus will be retrieval questions. We will be taught how to read and interpret the question, locate the answer in the text and how to record the answer to the question.

Spellings

Children will learn a new spelling pattern each week. Children will learn ten spellings a week. These will be taught in school. A copy of spellings can be found on the school website under Class 2.

History

In history this term we will be exploring significant historical female figures and the impact they had in their lifetime and beyond. Our learning question is: **What have we learnt from the work of Florence Nightingale?** We will look in detail at the work of Florence Nightingale and the lasting impact she had on healthcare on Great Britain. We will contrast her life with Edith Cavell, and Harriet Tubman, discovering what they have in common.

PE

The children will have PE lessons on Mondays and Tuesdays. The children will be learning skills in athletics and sending and receiving.

DT

This half term the children will work on structures. They will explore what stable structures are before planning, designing and making an indestructible chair for Baby Bear.

Maths Skills

Throughout this term, children will learn:

- **Counting** – will count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning at any number; pupils will count in 2's, 3's 5's and 10's to 100;
- **Number** – we will cement their knowledge of number operations. Our will focus on addition and subtraction, and we will work on multiplication, division and fractions.
- **Calculation** – both year groups will cement their knowledge of number operations. We will work on multiplication, division and fractions.
- **Geometry** – position and direction, left and right, whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns
- **Measures** – compare and describe length and height, compare, describe and measure mass and capacity; comparing time

It is important that Year 2 know their multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. All pupils have access to Time Table Rockstars to practise these.

Literacy Skills

This half-term we will start by writing some instructions explaining how to brush our teeth linking to our PHSCE lessons last term.

We will then write a recount of our class trip to Normanby Park sequencing events in the correct order.

The children will use a range of GPaS skills these will include: imperative verbs, expanded noun phrases, question marks and exclamation marks, subordinating and co-ordinating conjunctions.

Computing

This term children will be introduced to on-screen programming through Scratch Jnr. The children will use a variety of sprites and backgrounds. They will explore the blocks and learn to join them as an introduction to algorithms. By the end of the unit they will have designed their own animation project.

Science

This term children will continue their work with plants and set up a range of experiments to investigate what a plant needs to stay healthy.

We will also be focusing on scientific enquiry and be planning experiments to develop these skills.

RE

This term our unit is Life Journey with a focus on Islam. This will pull the golden threads together as we think about belonging.

Music

The children will explore sound and create a story through music. They will also further develop understanding of the meaning of genre, pulse, beat and rhythm.
