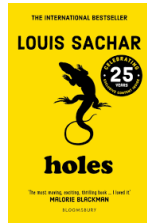


# Wrawby St Mary's C of E Primary School

## Year 6 Summer Term 1 2025



Our class reading for pleasure book is: Holes by Louis Sachar. Wrongly accused of stealing sneakers, Stanley Yelnats is sentenced to 18 months at Camp Green Lake correctional facility. The boys there dig holes daily in the hot sun, supposedly to “build character” — but Stanley soon discovers the warden is actually hunting for a treasure tied to Stanley’s ancestors. As he masters his digging skills and rescues a fellow inmate, Stanley’s self-confidence grows. He also discovers the treasure may be closer than anyone realizes.



**Maths Skills** This half term will be focusing on:

**Number:**— consolidating formal written methods of the four rules when solving problems and multi-step problems

**Ratio and Proportion** – continuing to calculate and solve problems involving percentages

**Fractions** – continuing to recall the equivalences between decimals, fractions and percentages; multiply and divide simple pairs of proper fractions

**Measures** – consolidating converting between different metric units of measure and solving problems involving these

**Geometry** – recapping the properties of both 2D and 3D shapes, angles on a straight line and around a point, nets and area.

**Statistics** – learning how to interpret pie charts using fractions and percentages and using these to solve problems

### **Geography**

This half term we learn about the world. We will recap the different continents in the world and how to locate different countries and cities. We will learn about the different time zones and the modern wonders. We will plan and describe a route across the world.

### **RE**

This half term we will be exploring ‘Was Jesus the Messiah?’. Through this topic, we will explain the place of incarnation and Messiah within the ‘big story of the bible’ and explore how Christians put their beliefs about Jesus’ incarnation into practice.

### **Science**

This half term we will be learning about electricity by building on our learning from Year 4. We will be constructing simple series circuits to help us answer questions about what happens when we try different components, for examples switches, bulbs, buzzers or motors. We will also learn how to represent a simple circuit in a diagram using recognized symbols.

### **Computing**

This term we will be learning how to use spreadsheets to format data to support calculations and apply formulas before using them to plan an event and answer questions by creating charts from the data.

### **English**

In the first weeks of this half term, we will be completing our shared write on ‘The piano’ video from the literacy shed. The children will be focusing on writing in present and past tense as the character experiences flashbacks. Our second piece of writing will be a discussing text on ‘Should Children at Wrawby St Mary’s Wear a School Uniform?’. As a class we will discuss the arguments, then use the evidence in our shared write to write a paragraph using Point, Evidence and Explanation and second and third person pronouns.

### **Art/DT**

This half term, in art, we will be exploring how we can make different shades of the same colour. We will explore how we can create different textures in our final piece of Art. In our final piece, we will use our painting skills to design and paint a picture from a familiar environment.



### **PE**

PE kits (named) should be brought to school on a Monday and taken home on a Friday. Our usual PE days will be on a Wednesday (Athletics) and a Friday (Striking and fielding).
