Our class reading for pleasure book for this half term is 'Secrets of a Sun King' by Emma Carroll.



We will be transported back to 1922, just at the point when the world was poised waiting for news about the discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb in Egypt, when our main character, Lil, decides the only way to help her grandad is to return a package to Egypt.

Maths Skills

This half term will be focusing on:

Number: Subtraction - subtracting four digit numbers using formal written methods.

Measurement: Length – converting between different units of measure, measuring and calculating the perimeter of a shape.

Number: Multiplication and Division – multiplying and dividing 2 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers using formal written methods

Geometry: Comparing and classifying geometric shapes including quadrilaterals and triangles, identifying lines of symmetry

History

In history, we will be learning all about the Ancient Egyptian civilization. We will be exploring: why the Ancient Egyptians resided by the Nile, how they communicated, their beliefs on the afterlife and how the Civilisation came to an end and how this was influenced by the Romans.

RE

This half term we will be asking how Hindu worship and celebration builds a sense of community and the ways in which this relates to beliefs about creation and the natural world.

Science



In science, we will be exploring what sound is and how it is made, before investigating how sound travels and how it can be insulated. We will be discovering how different instruments make their unique sound comparing size and shape, whilst investigating size and shape as well as pitch and volume.

Computing

This half term we will be exploring the World Wide Web, finding out what they can access, add to and create securely and safely. We will evaluate online content to decide its reliability.

Literacy Skills

Our first piece of writing, this half term, will be poetry. Linking to previous geography unit about rivers and using 'The River' by Valerie Bloom as inspiration, the children will write a rhyming poem about the features of the River Ancholme from the source to the sea.

Our second piece of writing is linked to last half term's science unit. The children will write an explanation text about the human digestive system using sub-headings, paragraphs and labelled diagrams to demonstrate their knowledge.

Art/DT

This half term, we will be exploring the transition from hunter gatherers to farmers. Children will find out how food can be farmed or grown elsewhere. Our end result will be to make bread and soup like in the Stone Age.
