## Autumn Term 2 2022



### Reading



This half term, we will enjoy delving into 'The Stolen Spear' by Saviour Spirotta. This story follows a young boy who has never left his village before uncovering many secrets.

### Maths Skills

Throughout this term, children will explore and apply their understanding of:

**Subtraction** - subtract numbers with up to three digits, using formal written methods of column subtraction

**Length** - measure and compare lengths in m, cm and mm. Also learning how to measure the perimeter of simple 2-D shapes.

**Multiplication** - recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 4 and 8 multiplication tables.

**Division** - learning how to write and calculate when a two digit number is divided by a one digit number.

**To help your child:** spend 5 mins a day chanting the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables. Also, use the TTRockstars login and move through the levels.

### History

This term, we consider the question:

#### **'What have archaeologists learnt from Early Britons?'**

Children will become historians by discovering how early Brits were different to us. We will learn about what they ate and how they communicated. We will explore what life would have been like for early settlers by analysing various secondary sources of evidence.

Children will also put historical events into order, thinking about the different eras in the Stone Age.



### RE

#### **Islamic worldview**

This half term we will be exploring the Islamic Worldview by learning 'What the main concepts in Islam reveal about the nature of Allah? What are the purposes of the visual symbols in a mosque?'

### Design and Technology

This half term, we will be exploring the transition from hunter gatherers to farmers. Children will find out how food can be farmed or grown elsewhere. Our end result will be to make bread and soup like in the Stone Age.

### Literacy Skills

Our first piece of writing, this half term, will be a discussion on 'Does Cleethorpes make a good holiday destination?' We will then produce a piece of writing discussing the pros and cons of Cleethorpes as a holiday destination.

After that, we will be using our science knowledge that we learnt last half term on magnets to write an explanation, our focus will be 'How do magnets help us?'

### Science This term, our Science focus will be '**Health and Movement.**'

We will be learning about nutrition and the right types of nutrition animals and humans need. We will explore how we get the nutrition from what we eat. We will also be exploring and identifying that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

When answering these questions, we will be working scientifically by grouping and classifying things, recording findings and noticing patterns.

### Computing

This half term the children will be using a range of techniques to create a stop-frame animation that will include music and text.

### PE

Children's designated PE days will be a Tuesday and a Friday. Children need to bring their PE kit into school on a Monday and take it home on a Friday. Please ensure all kit is clearly named.
