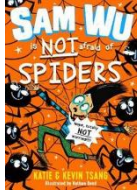

Reading



This half term, we will enjoy delving into 'Sam Wu is NOT afraid of spiders' By Katie and Kevin Tsang which tells the story of Sam Wu who is working hard on his bravery.

Geography

This term, we consider the question
'How is our community different from others?'

Children will become geographers by being able to make comparisons about villages, towns and cities. We will be able to explore and identify the key feature of Cleethorpes (resort) and Immingham (port) and the difference between them. We will begin to understand compass point in between north, east, south and west. Finally, we will plan a journey to different points of interests in Cleethorpes.



RE

Hindu worldview

This half term we will be exploring the Hindu Worldview by learning about sacred texts, stories and learn about the divine through these stories.

ART

This half term our art will relate to our geography by linking it to the River Humber. The children will be learning the skills of shading, hatching and stippling alongside pattern and texture to create a final drawing of the Humber Bridge.

Maths Skills

Throughout this term, children will explore and apply their understanding of:

time- understanding a.m. and p.m., and tell and write the time from an analogue clock and 12-hour clocks.

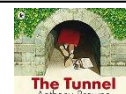
Number and place value- Recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number.

Addition- Add numbers mentally, including a three-digit number and ones, tens or hundreds.

Subtraction- Subtract numbers mentally including a three-digit number and ones, tens or hundreds.

To help your child spend 5 mins a day Chanting the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables. Also, use the TTRockstars login and move through the levels.

Literacy Skills



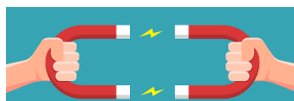
Our first piece of writing, this half term, will be to innovate a narrative called 'The Tunnel' By Anthony Browne. 'The tunnel' tells the story of a brother and sister who are taken to a world of imagination.

After that, we will be creating poetry using the 'I asked the little boy who cannot see' as a stimulus to write rhyming couplets.

Science This term, our Science focus will be, '**Forces and magnets**'.

Children will answer these questions:

- What are forces?
- How do objects move?
- How do magnets work?
- What materials are magnetic?
- How do magnets differ in strength?
- How can magnets be used?
- Can I explain how magnets attract or repel each other?



When answering these questions we will be working scientifically by grouping and classifying things and carrying out simple comparative and fair tests.

Computing

We will be exploring digital devices by comparing digital and non digital devices. We will discover the benefits of connecting devices in a network.
