In reading we will....



Our daily story time book will be a selection of stories, including The Little Red Hen, Owl babies by Martin Waddell and Little people, big dreams: Vanessa Nakate.

Phonics/Read Write Inc

We follow the Read Write Inc phonic programme. In Reception, the children will learn a new sound each day and then use these sounds to blend words to read them. Whilst they are learning the fundamentals to reading, they will bring home a wordless book for them to practise story-telling. In Year 1, the children will bring home a book matched to their reading ability. Please practise reading these books daily, where possible. All children will bring home a reading for pleasure book, which may be read by yourselves with your child. The children will bring these books home in a zip wallet. Please have these in your child's bag daily.

Spellings

In Year 1, children will learn a new spelling pattern each week. Children will learn ten spellings a week. These will be taught in school. A copy of spellings can be found on the school website under Reception/Year 1.

Geography

The learning question for this half term is 'What can be found in our local area?'

During this unit we will be developing our knowledge on where we live with a focus in the River Ancholme. The children will be able to describe where and how a river flows and the know the River Ancholme flows through Brigg.



Maths Skills

Reception will learn:

- **Counting** – Subitising to 3, counting objects using 1:1 correspondence, comparing numbers (more, less and equal)
- **Time** – Before/after, days of the week

Year 1 will learn:

- **Place value** - Count to and back from 20, understanding the value of, being able to write these numbers. Ordering numbers and finding missing numbers.
- **Calculation** – One more and one less, finding the total of two single digit numbers, introduction of the equals sign in a number sentence
- Practice the formation of the digits 0 – 9
- **Time** – Days of the week, months of the year

All of the above will be taught and learned through an engaging combination of games, challenges and investigations, both independently and with their peers.

Literacy Skills

Our driving text will be, 'The three little pigs. We will be asking questions about the text, sequencing events; recognising and joining in with predictable phrases; creating story maps; and retelling the story. After this, we will be creating a wanted poster to find the wolf. We will be learning to describe using adjectives.

In Reception, children will be learning the formation of letters and recording initial sounds. In Year 1, demarcating sentences with capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Computing

Reception children will learn how to handle ipads, including turning them on and off. They will learn how to use QR codes.

Year 1 children will learn about different types of technology. They will learn the different parts of a computer, including the keyboard and the mouse. They will consider how to use technology safely.

Science

The children will learn about animals including humans. They will name their body parts and their five senses. They will learn about their teeth, how to look after them and which foods to eat to keep their teeth healthy. Throughout the year the children will learn about the weather and look for signs of the changing seasons.

PE

The children will have PE lessons on Mondays and Fridays. They will be playing some invasion games, including dribbling, passing and shooting and developing their skills in athletics.

Art

The children will develop sketching skills using different mediums such as pencil, charcoal and ink. They will study the children's author and illustrator Oliver Jeffers and use their developing sketching skills in his style.

RE

This term, we will learn about what makes them special and unique. They will get to learn about other people too, including people with different world views.

Music

The children will be taught by Miss Oliver who will teach them songs and how to play instruments.
