The Wow Times



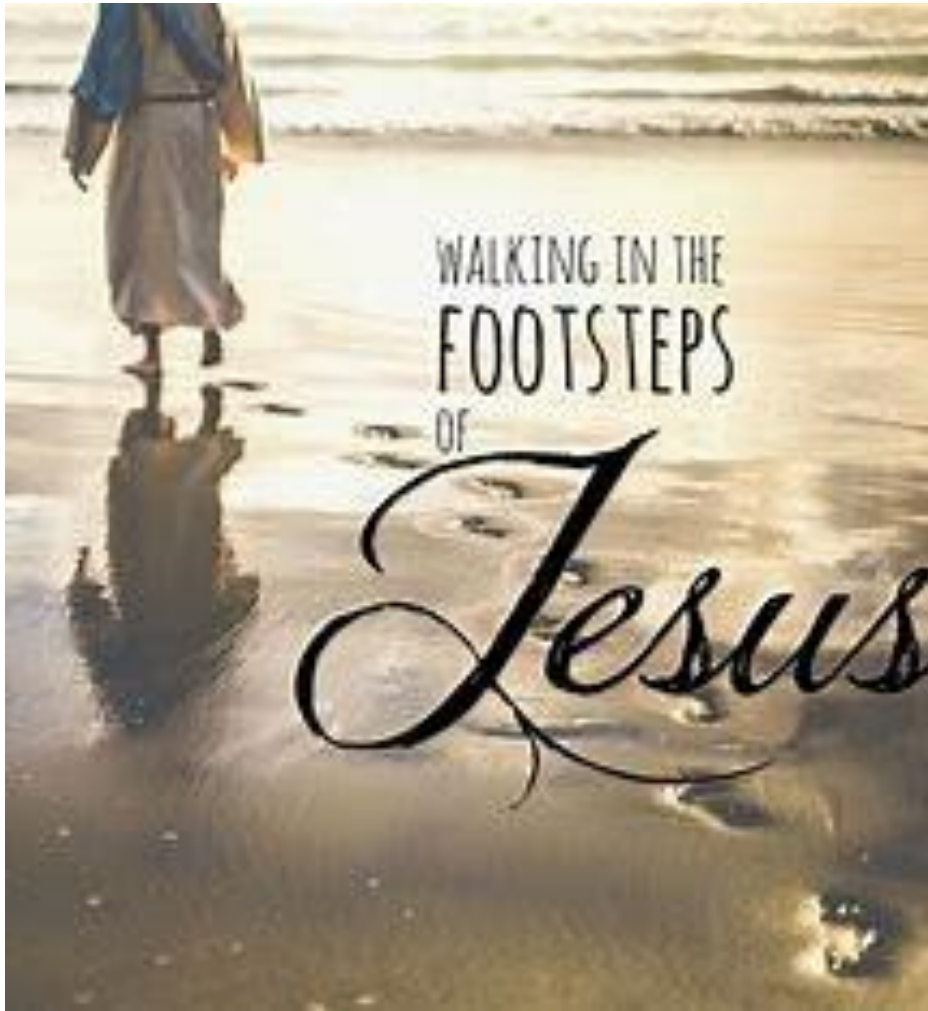
