Street Child, by Berlie Doherty, is a historical fiction novel based on the true story of Jim Jarvis, an orphan in 1860s Victorian London who flees the workhouse and endures harsh conditions on the streets, eventually inspiring Dr. Barnardo to open his famous children's homes. The book follows Jim's fight for survival, from losing his family to being exploited by a cruel coal lighter, highlighting themes of poverty, resilience, and humanity.

Literacy Skills

This term we will look at recounts, where we will be writing a diary entry in the style of 'Jim Jarvis'. We will focus on further developing our knowledge on semi-colons and passive voice, while using similes and metaphors and high-level vocabulary to add to the description.

In the second half of this term, we will create a narrative based on 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe'. We will focus on our relative clauses and develop characterisation and using dialogue to advance the action and begin to input dashes for an afterthought.

Science

This term in science, we will learn about evolution. We will explore inherited characteristics and why there are variations and we will then move on to learn about how animals and plants have adapted to their habitats and how natural selection effects this.

RE

This term we will be exploring the question 'Do people always put their belief into action?' Within this unit, we will explore many different perspectives and case studies while learning All human beings have certain agreed rights, many Christians believe that all people are made in image of God and so everyone should be treated with dignity and respect and that the Bible contains texts that refer to equality, justice and injustice, including slavery.

ART

This term class 4 will be looking at printing in the style of 'pop art'. They will explore artists such as Andy Warhol and Maria Qamar and re-create some of their famous work before planning and printing their own piece of pop art, inspired by the artists.



Geography

This term we will be travelling 'around the world in 80 days'. We will explore capital cities and use our fieldwork skills to locate and label these onto a map accurately, understand and calculate time zones and explore the seven wonders of the world. Finally, children will plan their own trip around the world, visiting each of the continents and sights, while factoring in time zones.

ICT

In this unit, Children will look at vector drawings. Using google drawings, they will learn how to create accurate vector drawing using shape, then using the zoom, lines of accuracy and order function to improve their designs. Children will then design and create their own design.
