### Literacy Skills

This term we will be writing a report in the style of a blog, linking to our Geography unit, about our 80 day trip around the world! We will focus on adapting our level of formality, expanded noun phrases and the use of dashes to separate independent clauses. In the second part of the term we will be writing an explanation text on 'How can I make a difference to our planet.' We will continue on adapting our level of formality, the use of passive voice and use of colons and semi-colons.

### Science

This term we will look at pioneers and leaders, where we will be researching the work of Eraina Hysolli, before planning an investigation based on her work and holding an ethical discussion surrounding the genetic engineering of the woolly mammoth. We will then go on to plan a social action project.

### RE

This term we will be exploring the question 'Do people always put their belief into action?' from a Muslim world view. Within this unit, we will also explore migration and seeking refuge. We will start to understand how Muslim sources of authority help Muslim understand justice and injustice and how context may shape the Muslim responses to injustice as Many Muslims, particularly in the global north, experience Islamophobia.

### History

This term, our unit will explore the question 'What was the Islamic Golden Age and how is it viewed today?'

We will look at when this age started, how the different areas were ruled and organised, the key achievements and what life was like for the different social groups before understanding why the Islamic Golden age declined.

### ICT

In this unit, Children will look at spread sheets. They will learn about how to input data into a spread sheet, how to use different formulas to calculate different sums and how to duplicate this formula to other cells, before presenting their data in other ways.

### DT

In DT, this term we will be exploring frame structures and using this knowledge to design and build our own kite. Pupils will develop skills such as Experience of using measuring, marking out, cutting, joining, shaping and finishing techniques with construction materials, learn a basic understanding of what structures are and how they can be made stronger, stiffer and more stable, designing and understand how to strengthen, stiffen and reinforce 3D frameworks.

### PE

This term PE will be on a Tuesday exploring Fencing and Wednesday exploring Tennis with Mr Brown.
